



The CPL Board of Trustees

The Chetwynd Public Library Board of Directors consists of eleven volunteer members. Nine members of the community are appointed for two year terms, and a District of Chetwynd Councillor as well as the PRRD Area E Rep. are members of the board. A member is eligible for re-appointment, but no member may serve for more than eight consecutive years. Board members must be residents of the Chetwynd area and must be over age 18.

Role of the Board

The public library board is a governance board which operates under the authority of the Library Act of British Columbia. The board is responsible for providing library services and programs in Chetwynd. Library trustees establish the policies, goals and objectives of the library and advocate for the library in the greater community. The day-to-day operation of the library is the responsibility of the Library Director and staff.

Time Commitment

The Library Board meets monthly on the last Wednesday of the month (about 2 hours). In addition, Board members may serve on various Board Committees such as policy & budget.

Other time commitments will include reviewing agenda items prior to meetings and attending occasional Board training sessions, strategic planning sessions and retreats, special events and fundraising activities.
