Library Director:

Thanked everyone who came out to support and take part in the Ground Breaking Ceremony. Annual stat survey is complete and submitted to the Province. Held interviews for the summer student positions. Student photo contest in partnership with Moccasin Flats, ChetTV and Chetwynd Secondary School went well. Spring programing wrapped up on June 10th including the Community Kitchen. Gardening kits have been a huge hit, as they are put together with a lot of thought and care. Included in the kits: pot, soil, plants, instructions, book and other little themed goodies such as a tea strainer for the tea kit plants. Wellness sessions have started back up. Touched base with the medical clinic team in regards to the DementiAbility kits that are available at the library. We ended up moving the fairy walk and storybook walk to a new location. It is located behind the Chetwynd Secondary School field on a section of the Cottonwood Trail. Pineridge Plumbing was in three times: May 04th, May 31st and June 10th to remove a blockage. Due to the amount of water in the drains with the abundance of rain, the District of Chetwynd will put a camera down at a later date in hopes of finding out what is going on.
