Library Director:

Update on where we are at with the public libraries accessibility committees and framework and what it may potentially look like. The province has an accessibility working group in place. Delivered the bank draft of \$840,000 to PRRD for the construction of the new library. Launched our Toy Lending Library, families are now able to check out sensory and themed based toys for their children. All Candidates Forum was held at the library. Addition to our regular library programs and library on location, this past month Gloria Millsap did a presentation for our Young@Heart group on the Falkland Island and Kathy Swanson did a meandering meditation. Revised the storybook walk with a pumpkin theme. We offered a free babysitter course and are currently facilitating a free Living Life to Full course through the Canadian Mental Health Association. Staff training for Food Safe and Standard First Aid. Also included was webinars and meetings attended as well as grants, funding,

stats and staff notes. The library received a thank you letter and donation from a couple who visited the library from Pinckney Michigan.
